The picture above is from the Casa Hogar Easter service, celebrating our risen Lord and Savior! What a wonderful blessing it was for our kids to be able to celebrate holy week together with Pastor Wesley and the staff of Casa Hogar.

Typically on Easter Sunday, we celebrate at a sunrise service in an amphitheater overlooking the Pacific Ocean, but obviously for all of us this year, Easter celebration looked very different and was celebrated in the courtyard of Casa Hogar. Our staff have been incredible during this time as they have helped the kids advance in learning, exercise, and their walk with Jesus each day. It has been a joy for me during this time to watch the Lord work at Casa Hogar from afar. Please be in prayer for the staff as they are working from long days with these children providing for their every need as well as helping them with school work and all other daily tasks. I know that many of you are in the same boat with your children, so I ask you to pray for our leaders as they each have 15-20 children to look after. Pray for our kids during this time that if they do not know Jesus as their Lord and Savior that through the different devotions they would come before His throne and accept Him as their Savior. As I have been praying for Casa Hogar and Acapulco in general, I have been specifically praying for our children's parents and siblings that are not at Casa Hogar. Acapulco beaches have now been closed for a little over a week which is a huge deal as the majority of the population in Acapulco lives off of a daily wage (selling stuff on the beach, restaurants, etc.) that depends on tourism. So during this COVID-19 crisis, I am asking you to join me in not just praying for our kids and leaders, but also for their families. Pray that this would be a time that Casa Hogar can be a light for the Gospel for these family members. Pray that the Lord would provide for them in a way that they can see how He is working in their lives. Thank you all for being so faithful in prayer for our family in Acapulco.
